The Federal Ministry of Education and Research nominated Dresden as one of Germany's eight "Cities of the Future". As such, Dresden will explore different ways towards a sustainable and innovative city that allows for a good, healthy life.



The path towards "Dresden – a city of the future"

2015

The Federal Ministry of Education and Research receives 160 concepts, submitted from 52 cities from all over Germany

2016

The Federal Ministry of Education and Research selects 23 cities, giving them the chance to work out the details of their concept

2017

300 active citizens of Dresden instigate 100 projects of the urban society

2018

25 of these projects initiated by citizens apply to the city of Dresden for support

The Federal Ministry of Education and Research selects 8 cities to implement their concepts

2019

"Dresden – city of the future" sets off to implement 8 citizens' projects

The projects of the City of the Future

What makes the projects so special is the fact that Dresden's citizens developed their ideas and smaller projects together with the science sector. Supported by the city administration, the citizens will implement them over the course of the next years. The project "The Bin", for example, wants to find out if and how a restaurant can be run using nothing but rejected food. The team behind "Facilitating Material" does research on how materials can be re-used sensibly instead of simply thrown away.
